Senior patrol leaders duties:

1. Runs all the troop meetings, events, activities and the annual program planning conference.
2. Runs the Patrol Leader's Council meeting.
3. Appoints other PLC members with the approval of the Scoutmaster.
4. Assign duties and responsibilities to junior leaders.
5. Assists the Scoutmaster with junior leader training.
6. Sets a good example.
7. Enthusiastically wears the Scout uniform correctly.
8. Lives by the Scout Oath, Law and Motto.
9. Shows Scout spirit.
10. Mentor other Scouts and members of PLC.
11. Participate in knowledge transfer with elected APSL.

Qualifications:

1. Advanced to the rank of Star or higher.
2. Served previous 6 months as ASPL.
3. Expected to attend Junior Leader Training.
4. Been registered member of BSA for at least 1 year.
5. Been a registered member of Troop 1104 for at least 6 months.
6. Received approval of the Scoutmaster.
7. Be present at 85% of Troop meetings, PLC meetings, and outings.
